Biography of Professor Wee Sang Park- Guest Editor



Wee Sang Park (M'89) received his BS degree in electronic engineering from Seoul National University, Korea, in 1974; and he received his MS and PhD degrees in electrical engineering from the University of Wisconsin-Madison, USA, in 1982 and 1986, respectively. From 1986 to 1988, he taught at Wichita

State University. He joined the Department of Electrical Engineering, Pohang University of Science and Technology, Korea in 1988, and retired in 2017. In 1997 he was on a sabbatical leave at the University of Utah. In 2005 and 2012 he worked for Samsung Electronics. He was director of the Antenna Laboratory at POSTECH, and conducted research on passive microwave devices such as phased-array antenna, small antenna, propagation in metamaterial, frequency selective surface, wireless power transfer, RFID radiator, and radiation of LSI. Professor Park was the symposium general chair of the ISMOT2017 conference held in Seoul, and is a member of the IEEE MTT and AP societies.
